The preservation of our surrounding environment is a company priority. Recycling is a smart and environmentally conscious choice that preserves resources and eliminates the critical environmental issue of proper disposal of concrete and asphalt.

All of our production operations are ISO14001 certified to international environmental management standards, which ensures all operations remain committed to the preservation of our surrounding environment.



Aggregate Industries accepts and recycles over 200,000 tons of concrete each year. These materials are processed into a recycled concrete base product, known as **CONPAC**. This product serves as a cost-effective alternative for structural fill, concrete sidewalk sub-base and can also be used in many other applications. We also have the ability to produce custom manufactured fills by combining **CONPAC** with other aggregate products.

We recycle over 750,000 tons of used, broken asphalt each year. These materials, which use to be sent to landfills, are recycled into new hot mix asphalt and other recycled base materials, thereby conserving non-renewable natural resources.

T-BASE is our recycled alternative sub-base course product. This product, which is a mixture of aggregates and crushed asphalt, is used as a recycled based course material.
